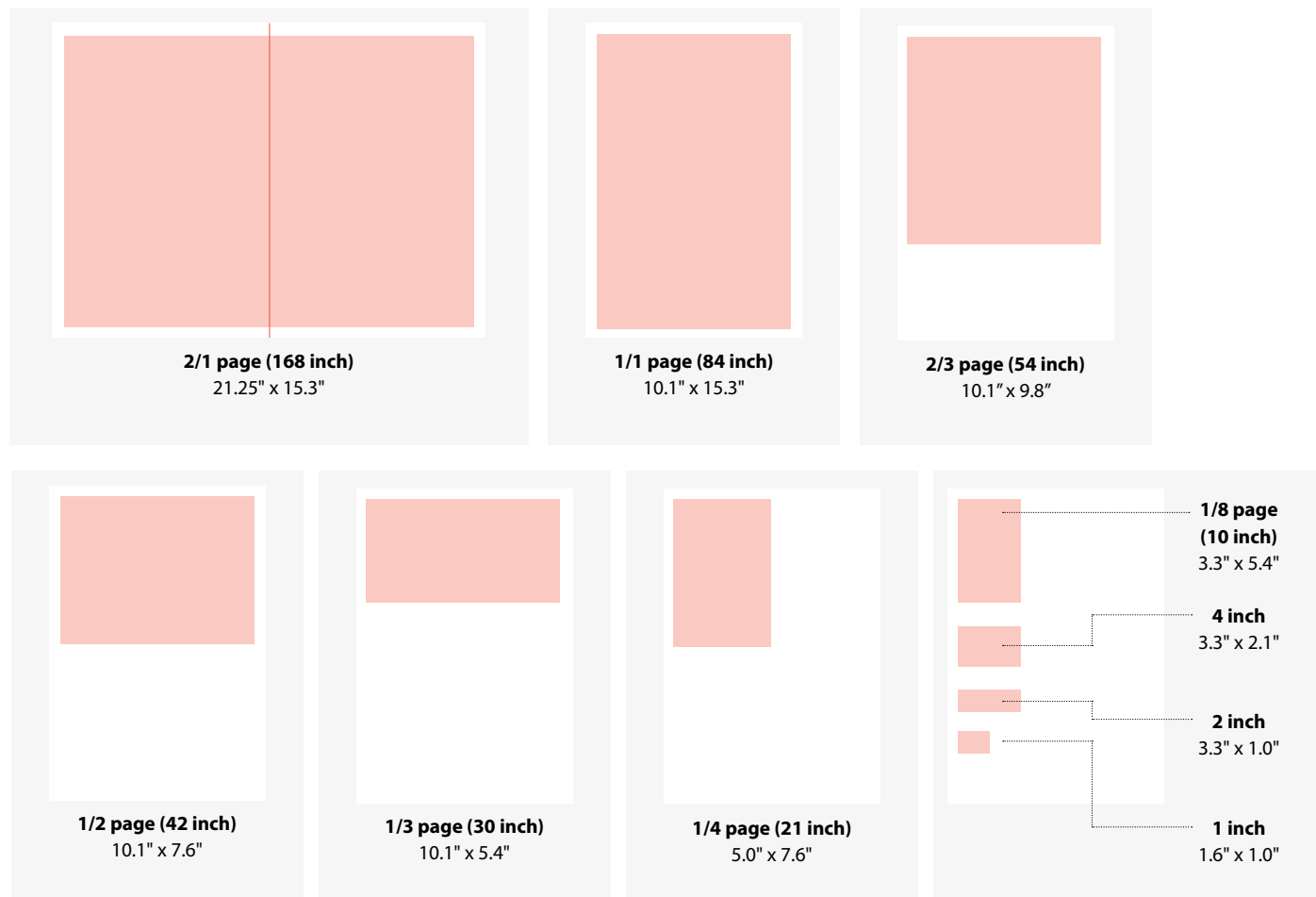

Tips for submitting text and pictures

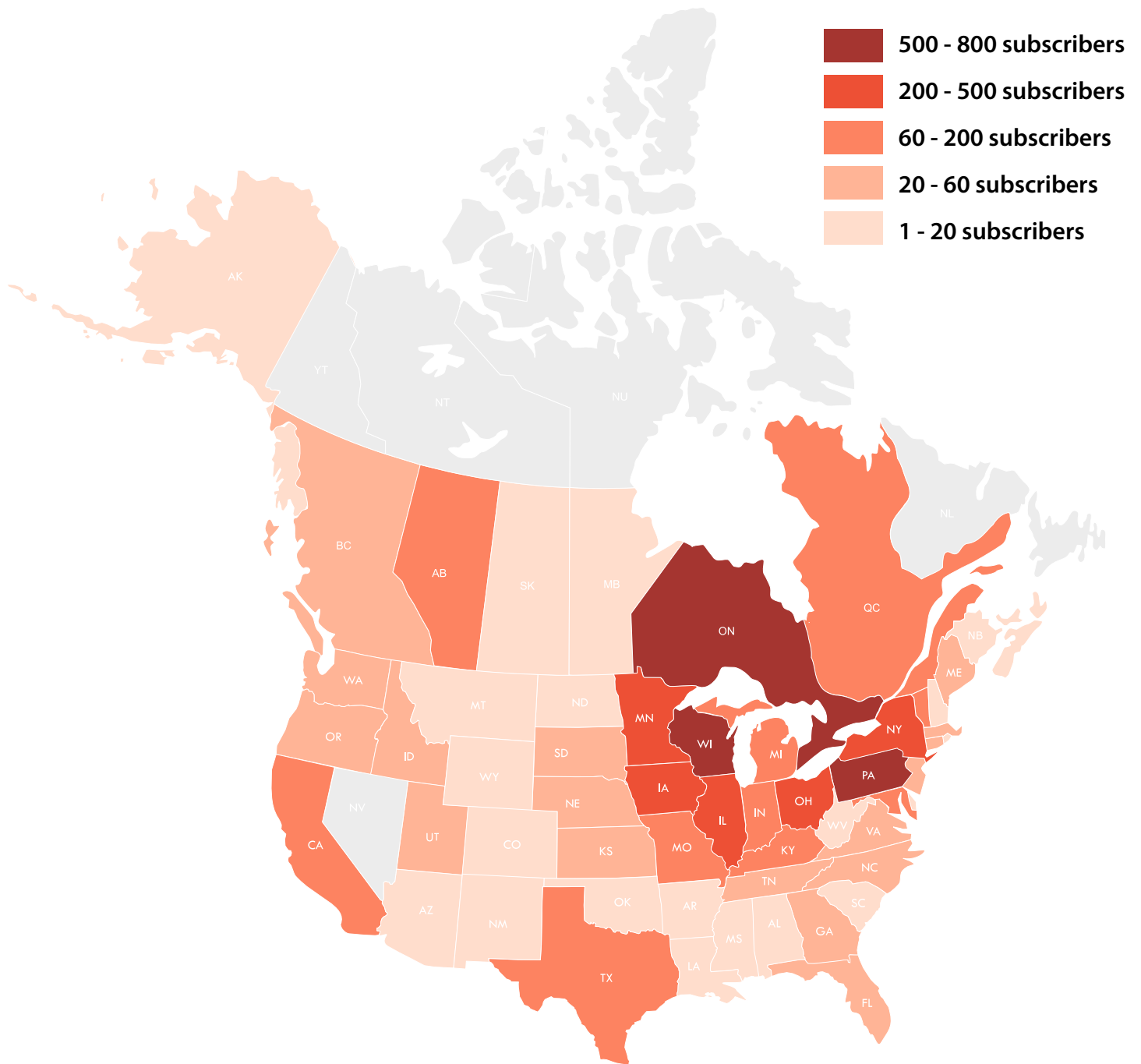
- Submitting text in Microsoft word or in the email message, unmade (no tabs or frames)
 - Pictures: high resolution – saved as .jpg, .eps, .psd, or .tif.
 - Logo's preferably formatted as vector file in Adobe Illustrator, or saved as .jpg, .eps, .psd, or .tif, in high resolution.
 - Send photos and texts directly to info@cattleconnection.com (provided the e-mail is smaller than 10 mb).
- For large files, please use WeTransfer.
